Budapest, 23 of March 2018

We, the representatives of Ministers of the V4 countries hereby would like to confirm our commitment to support young talents.

Acknowledging the essential power and practice of the free movement of young people, we consider the exploration of the negative consequences of brain drain important.

We strive to share our researchers, professional workshops, results through the organization of conferences, exchanges and encouraging joint projects.

Furthermore, we strive to share school and non-school related best practices at various levels of education.

In accordance with the aims of the International Visegrad Fund, emphasizing our joint endeavors to share best practices, we explore the possibility of including talent management in support of the objectives in the field of education.

We consider the joint reflection of the V4 countries primarily important in order to formulate common solutions to similar problems in talent management.
