FAO's Shared Services Centre (SSC) in Budapest is calling for expression of interest to identify qualified candidates for potential assignments as Business/System Analyst. The SSC in Budapest has been operational since January 2008, currently employing around 150 persons, its main task is to provide administrative services to FAO offices worldwide.

The SSC office in Budapest uses Oracle ERP R12 and other corporate management systems that require continuous improvement. The SSC is also currently carrying out a project to implement a Single Point of Contact and related process and technology changes to enhance high customer service orientation.

Tasks and responsibilities:

The incumbent will work under the supervision of an SSC Officer and be part of the business analysis team.

In particular the incumbent will be involved in

- (1) Oracle ERP system functional changes and
- (2) Implementation of Single Point of Contact

Activities:

- Document AS-IS and TO-BE processes in relation to process and system changes
- Write relevant project and design documents
- Coordinate or participate in system testing activities, including writing test plans and test cases, and documenting test results
- Coordinate or participate in deployment activities, including development of training materials and procedures, user identification and provision, organizing and running information sessions etc.
- Support end users and other team members in activities related to the achievement of the project objectives
- Perform any other project related duties

- System test documents
- Training materials
- Procedures

Candidates should meet the following requirements:

- Strong academic background in business administration, IT, change management or other related field. Bachelor degree or higher is required
- Experience in large scale business change management and/or system implementation initiatives
- Good knowledge of modern client servicing technology and the SSC industry AND/OR good knowledge of Oracle ERP Human Resources and Finance modules
- Experience working in an international environment preferred
- Fluency in English (written and oral). Working knowledge of French, Spanish, Arabic, Chinese or Russian will be considered an asset.
- Ability to think and work logically and precisely with attention to detail. Initiative, sound judgment and demonstrated ability to work with personnel of different national and cultural backgrounds.
